<Request to visitors >

- Measuring temperature by thermography
- Wearing a mask and using hand sanitizer
- Meeting in the conference room with acrylic board

The above will be implemented as appropriate according to the scale of each branch and the infection status of said location.

<Prevention measures in the office>

1) Measures on infection prevention and health management

- Applicants completed workplace vaccination by August 22, 2021
- Wearing face masks and carrying out proper manners for coughing at the workplace is required
- Frequent hand wash and disinfection of hands is required.
- Shared places(door knobs, light switches, etc.) are regularly disinfected.
- Social distancing and ventilation in the workplace
- Employees must check their body temperature every morning (Employees with a fever of over 37.5°C or any other symptoms related to COVID-19 will be ordered to stay at home)
- The workplace of the employee ordered to stay at home will be disinfected.
- If a family member of an employee is suspected of showing symptoms of COVID-19, the employee will be ordered to stay at home.

2) Measures on commute and work

- Flexible work hours is enforced to lessen the risk of being infected during commute.
- Utilizing web conference systems is enforced.

3) Measures on business trips

- International business trips are prohibited.
- Attending online lectures and seminars are encouraged.

We will continue to take measures to prevent infection with the highest priority on ensuring the safety of all employees.
